OBSERVE SCHOOL ZONE SPEEDS

- Follow Posted Speed Limits: Always adhere to the speed limits, especially in school zones.
- Drive Slowly: Maintain reduced speeds throughout the day, not just during drop-off and pickup times.
- Be Cautious: Kids may be out at recess, lunch, and during class changes, so adjust your speed accordingly.

BE AWARE AT CROSSWALKS

- Slow Down: Approach crosswalks with caution and be prepared to stop at any moment.
- Stay Vigilant: Always be alert for sudden movements or distractions, especially near schools.
- Drive Cautiously: Adjust your speed and attention in areas where children are likely to be present.
- Yield to Pedestrians: Always stop for pedestrians at crosswalks and ensure they have safely crossed before proceeding.
- Look Both Ways: Even if you have the right of way, double-check for any pedestrians who might be crossing unexpectedly.
- Obey the Crossing Guard: A crossing guard's job is to keep kids safe. If you are at a light and it turns green, you must still obey the crossing guard's signal as children are still crossing.

WATCH FOR CHILDREN

- Stay Alert: Children can be easily distracted, so keep a watchful eye on the road.
- Be Prepared: Quick reflexes could be crucial in avoiding accidents.
- Keep an Eye Out: Kids might step out from between parked cars, off sidewalks, or open car doors into traffic.

FOLLOW SCHOOL BUS PROTOCOLS

- Stop for School Buses: When a school bus has its stop sign extended and lights flashing, you must stop and wait until the bus moves or the signals are turned off.
- Keep a Safe Distance: Maintain a safe distance behind school buses and be prepared for frequent stops.
- Never Pass: Do not pass a school bus from behind or from either direction when it is stopped to load or unload kids.
- Watch for Children: Be extra vigilant for children getting on or off the bus, and ensure they have safely crossed the road before proceeding.
